I am requesting funding for the Oakville Waltz Road rehabilitation project in surface transportation reauthorization legislation.

The project sponsor for this project is Monroe County Road Commission and the project is located at Oakville Waltz Road, London Township, MI, 48160 and 48191.

The funding is designated for hot mix asphalt resurfacing, excavation, aggregate base, full-depth reclamation, drainage, guardrails, slope restoration, permanent signing, and pavement construction.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars and is anticipated to have the following benefits:

- The rehabilitation project will improve safety by adding paved shoulders to reduce lane departure crashes, upgrading the curve warning signs, and by improving the pavement condition.
- The rehabilitation project will increase corridor continuity at a county border road by creating 12-foot-wide lanes and 3-foot-wide paved shoulders.
- The rehabilitation project will create a continuous All-Season Truck Route from the City of Milan to Rawsonville Road.
