Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:


I am requesting funding for the Albion Senior Housing Initiative in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Albion, located 112 West Cass St., Albion, MI 49224. The funding would be used to support site preparation, infrastructure development, and foundational construction for Phases I and II of a new senior housing campus, including 50–75 independent living units and a 25-bed assisted living facility, with infrastructure capacity to support future expansion.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it addresses a shortage of senior housing in the community, leverages private capital investment, supports aging in place, strengthens the local housing market, creates construction and healthcare-related jobs, and promotes long-term economic stability in the Albion community.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
