Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:


I am requesting funding for the Water Infrastructure Improvements Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Village of White Pigeon, located at 103 South Kalamazoo St. White Pigeon MI, 49099. The funding would be used to install a new drinking water well, new well house, a water-main that directly feeds into the distribution system and into the water tower, and fencing around the perimeter of the well field and water tower.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because making these necessary updates will provide much needed improvements to water quality and the grounds protecting this critical infrastructure. The project will also provide relief to residents and businesses in the community knowing they have clean drinking water.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized under Section 306 of the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act, 7 U.S. Code section 1926(a)(2).
